
Cubic
(3 cleavages at right angles; e.g. halite)




Octahedral
(4 cleavages, 8 sides; e.g. fluorite)





Dodecahedral
(6 cleavages, 12 sides; e.g. fluorite)



Rhombohedral
(3 cleavages not at right angles; e.g. calcite, dolomite)



Prismatic
(2 cleavages of many possible angles; e.g. pyroxene, amphibole, feldspar)



Basal
(1 cleavage; e.g. biotite, muscovite)
